On April 2nd, Governor Gretchen Whitmer signed [Executive Order 2020-35](#) which officially announced the closure of school facilities in Michigan for the remainder of this school year as a result of the COVID-19 coronavirus pandemic. School districts are required by the Executive Order to develop plans for educating their students remotely.

The Learning Continuity Plan for Pansophia Academy will include continued educational opportunities for all students through use of online communication tools. Teachers have already started reaching out to families to get this process underway. Once our learning continuity plan is approved, we will post it on our website and Facebook page.

We will continue to distribute meals on Tuesdays from Noon - 2:00 P.M. from the Abbott Avenue loop. Parents can also make arrangements to pick up printed materials from teachers, students' personal items, and borrowed Chromebook during this time.
